**What is a Family Resource Center?** The primary goal of a family resource center is to **help** individuals and families “**connect**” to Alabama health and human services through an **intake, assessment and referral** process. Family Services Centers are the “**go to**” for Alabama citizens needing services and/or seeking assistance in navigating public and private services. They are locally based centers that help coordinate and mobilize available resources in order to support and strengthen families. Some centers also offer additional programs at their centers through collaboration and partnerships with others. Centers are found in a variety of settings to include schools, churches, community buildings, and sharing space with private or public agencies.
